Christmas Celebration 2021

Dear parents and carers,

I am writing with some further details of our Christmas Celebration to be held on Thursday at the United Reformed Church. In light of the changing picture nationally we have had to put in some additional precautions for this event to take place as safely as possible.

Firstly, please could we ask that, as ever, **no children attend school if they are unwell** (either Covid symptoms or otherwise) or have tested positive in the last ten days. Similarly please **do NOT attend to watch the event if you feel unwell or have tested positive for Covid in the last 10 days**. We would politely request all adults to take a **lateral flow test at home** on the day and not attend if it shows a positive result.

Seating in the church will be **socially distanced between families**. The available seating is more limited than usual with alternate pews closed so we are asking a **maximum of 2 adults per child/ family to attend** please. Adults will be checked in against their child's name at the door. Please do not sit in the pews marked as out of use.

All adults watching will need to wear a **face covering** for the duration of their time in the church.

Please could pushchairs etc... not be left in aisles as some of the children will be walking around the church as part of the performance.

The performance is due to start at 1.45pm and will finish around 2.15pm. If you are watching the performance and wish to take your child home straight after the performance this will be fine, otherwise we will walk them back to school for the usual collection time. Guidance will be given in the church to ensure children are handed over safely.

You will be welcome to photograph and video the event for your own use but we ask that you do not share these on social media at all.

We are very pleased to still be going ahead with this special event, which we really missed last Christmas. Please help us to run the event safely by adhering to these precautions.
