WHAT IS THE ROLE OF A GOVERNOR?

The Governing Body has three main core functions:

- ◆ Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction;
- ◆ Holding executive leaders to account for the educational performance of the organisation and its pupils, and the performance management of staff; and
- ◆ Overseeing the financial performance of the organisation and making sure its money is well spent.
